



## **TOOL // Kindergarten Class Personal and Social Development Profile**

### **What is the tool?**

A class profile of student demonstration of personal and social development.

### **What is it used for?**

The tool allows the teacher and ECE to collect and collate evidence of student achievement of Kindergarten Personal and Social Development.

### **How do you use it?**

The tool is kept easily accessible to both the teacher and the ECE to record observations of students' developing personal and social skills. They can record using the key letters; L-Little Evidence, B-Beginning, D-Developing, ME-Meeting Expectations and jot notes if needed. A profile is completed each month so a collaborative plan to support student growth can be developed.
